

WARWICK RACECOURSE LADIES DAY COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. By entering the Best Dressed Ladies Day competition at Warwick Racecourse, the terms and conditions (as defined below), entrants agree to be bound by these Rules and your attention is specifically drawn to the conditions No. 10, No.13 and No. 18.
2. In the event of any dispute regarding the Rules, conduct, results and all other matters relating to the Ladies Day Best Dressed Competition, the decision of Warwick Racecourse shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
3. To qualify to enter the Ladies Day Best Dressed Competition, you must be resident in the United Kingdom, Republic of Ireland and/or the Isle of Man. The address you provide with your competition entry ("Entry") may be used to send any prizes so please make sure this is correct.
4. Warwick Racecourse assumes that by reading the publication or by using the website and entering the Ladies Day Competition (and you warrant that) you are aged 18 or over.
5. Employees of Warwick Racecourse or any associated company of Warwick Racecourse and Judges of the Ladies Day competition, their immediate families, persons connected with the competition i.e. prize sponsors, newsagents, wholesalers & their agents are not able to enter the Best Dressed Competition.
6. By entering the Competition, you hereby warrant that all information submitted by you is true, current and complete. Warwick Racecourse reserves the right to verify the eligibility of all entrants.
7. Warwick Racecourse reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of the Rules.
8. Only one entry per person per Competition is allowed, any entrant who enters more than the permitted maximum will be disqualified.
9. Where the Ladies Day Best Dressed winner has been selected and Warwick Racecourse discovers or has reasonable grounds to believe the winner has made more than one Entry, Warwick Racecourse reserves the right to select an alternative winner.
10. To enter the Ladies Day competition, racegoers must visit the competition area, this is located near the parade ring, where competitors will be asked to complete a form.
11. Entries to the Ladies Day Best Dressed competition will be open from 5pm.
12. Entries to Warwick Racecourses' Ladies Day Best Dressed Competition must be made by the closing time of 7pm on Saturday 12th May 2018. Failure to do so will disqualify the entry.
13. A ticket is required to enter the Racecourse. There is no purchase requirement to enter the Ladies Day Best Dressed Competition.
14. Entrants should note that unless stated otherwise, Warwick Racecourse does not accept responsibility for the return of any Entries, including those consisting of artistic or other material.
15. Prize winners will be contacted via call and text on the day of the competition, Saturday 12th May 2018.
16. The winners will be selected by a panel of three independent judges.
17. The selection of the best dressed, 1st prize, 2nd prize and 3rd prize and best hat 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize will be agreed by the three independent judges.
18. The independent judges do not have a contractual relationship with the promoter or work for a company that has had a contractual relationship with the promoter, or have any other relationship with the promoter or such company, if the nature of the relationship could compromise their independence.

19. Judges full names are available on request.

20. A) No correspondence will be entered into relating to our independent judges, whose decision is final.

21. Claims for prizes must be made on the day. Failure to claim a prize by 8:00pm on Saturday 12th May 2018 will result in disqualification and your prize may be donated to Racing Welfare.

22. Warwick Racecourse Best Dressed Prizes are non-transferable and there is no cash alternative. Warwick Racecourse reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value at any time.

23. Warwick Racecourse Best Dressed prizes are awarded at the discretion of Warwick Racecourse and no prizes will be awarded as a result of improper actions by or on behalf of any entrant.

24. Prize winners shall not, under any circumstances whatsoever, sell or transfer their prize to any other person(s) within six months of Saturday 12th May 2018. Selling or transferring prizes includes, but is not limited to, selling and/or distributing on any website including any auction site whether it is operated by a third party or by a prize winner. Should the prize winner sell or attempt to sell any prize within six months, the prize winner agrees to repay the full market value of the prize to Warwick Racecourse who will in turn transfers funds to Racing Welfare.

25. Your Warwick Racecourse Best Dressed entry and any information submitted by you must be personal to and relate specifically to you. You hereby warrant that your entry and all information which you submit and/or distribute will not infringe the intellectual property, privacy or any other rights of any third party, and will not contain anything which is libellous, defamatory, obscene, indecent, harassing or threatening. If relevant, Warwick Racecourse reserves the right, but not the obligation, to screen, filter and/or monitor information provided by you and to edit, refuse to distribute or remove the same.

Warwick Racecourse cannot accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by any entrant entering the Best Dressed competition or as a result of accepting any prize. Warwick Racecourse is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer online systems, servers, or providers, computer equipment or software, failure of any email or entry to be received on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet, telephone lines or at any web site, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer or mobile telephone related to or resulting from participation in the Competition. Nothing shall exclude Warwick Racecourse's liability for death or personal injury as a result of its negligence.

27. Winners may be requested to take part in promotional activity and Warwick Racecourse reserves the right to use the names and addresses of winners in any publicity both in paper and online.

29. Data relating to entrants of the Best Dressed Competition will be retained by Warwick Racecourse for a reasonable period after the Competition closes to assist Warwick Racecourse to operate competitions in a consistent manner and to deal with any queries in the best dressed Competition.

30. The Best dressed Competition and Rules will be governed by English law and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England. Where the site and/or the Interactive Services are accessed from Scotland or Northern Ireland, this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of Scotland or Northern Ireland respectively and you hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Scottish courts or the courts of Northern Ireland respective.
